

# OSCAR WOODS' JIG

Named after Oscar Woods, a melodeon player from Benhall Green, near Saxmundham. Oscar Woods was inspired to play after hearing farmworker 'Tiger' Smith play – the tune is sometimes also known as Tiger Smith's jig. This one's a popular session tune in England – particularly in East Anglia and fits well with our session repertoire.
